with reference to the request to begin the **internship/research period abroad**, without prejudice to the  
insurance coverage prepared by the University of Trento in relation to accidents and civil liability, declare  
under my own responsibility:

a) to keep constantly updated on the measures and to observe the rules for the prevention and management  
of the COVID-19 emergency and, in particular, to have read and accepted the entry conditions provided by  
the country of destination for those arriving from Italy (or from my current country of residence) and for those  
returning to Italy from the host country, such as possible quarantine, restrictions, etc.;

b) to have read and accepted the conditions for the provision of services at the destination  
University/Institution, such as methods of conducting out on-line teaching and any limitations in accessing  
basic services such as university accommodation and canteens, etc.;

c) to purchase a health insurance policy that explicitly covers any hospitalization costs related to COVID-19;

d) to purchase travel insurance which covers any cancellations or delays due to the COVID-19 emergency;

e) to exonerate the University of Trento and its employees from all liability related to any costs incurred for  
the circumstances listed above and for any unexpected events related to the interruption or cancellation of  
my mobility for reasons related to the COVID-19 emergency.

**INFORMATION REGARDING PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING**

According to art. 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679, “General Data Protection Regulation” - GDPR the University of Trento provides the Data subject with the following information.

**1. Data controller and Data Protection officer**

**2. Purposes and legal basis for processing**

The processing of the provided personal data is performed by the University of Trento staff in charge, in the public interest as stated by article 6, paragraph 1, point e); in particular for the purpose of managing the selection procedures for the admission to the International Mobility program for doctoral internship/research abroad.

**3. Mandatory data provision**

The provision of the requested data is necessary to manage the selection procedures and any refusal to provide the requested data will render it impossible for the University of Trento to proceed.

**4. How data is processed**

Data is processed both in automated means and in other than by automated means (paper form) by University of Trento staff in charge in relation to the task carried out and respecting the principles of lawfulness, fairness and transparency, purpose limitation (for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes), data minimization (in relation to the purposes for which they are processed) and in a manner that ensures appropriate security of the personal data. No automated decision-making is done.

**5. Recipients of personal data and transfer to a third country**

Personal data collected in the following form may be transferred to third parties if necessary to carry on the procedure and/or to comply with legal obligations (European or National) and/or Judicial Authority or Police orders. The disclosure of your Personal Data to the Host University/Institution is strictly limited to those data that are necessary for your identification as the beneficiary of the International Mobility Programme. In case the Host University/Institution is located in an extra EU country, in the absence of an adequacy decision pursuant to Article 45(3), or of appropriate safeguards pursuant to Article 46, please be informed that the proceeding of your Personal Data by the Host Institution could be subject to risks, such as, for example, the absence of a Supervisory Authority, the lack of rules on Personal data processing and the rights and freedoms of the Data Subject. Your personal data is thus transferred to the Host University/Institution only on the basis of your explicit consent (art. 49 par.1 point b) GDPR) and in any case for the purposes of the conclusion or the application of your mobility contract (art. 49 par.1 point b). The lack of an explicit consent to the transfer of Personal Data will render impossible your participation to the International Mobility program.

**6. Data retention period**

Personal data are processed for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected, until the conclusion of the procedure and according to requirements stated by law (e.g. current legislation on the retention and archiving of Administrative documents).

**7. Rights of the data subjects**

The data subject shall have the right to obtain from the controller the rights stated by the articles 15 et seq. of the GDPR, in particular: the access to personal data, the rectification and the integration, the restriction of processing or the right to object to processing of personal data. Within the meaning of the article 17, paragraph point 3b), the right to erasure do not subsist when the processing of the data is mandatory to ensure the performance of tasks carried out in the public interest. A specific request can be submitted to the Data protection officer at the above address for the exercise of the rights. The data subject shall have right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority - the Italian Data Protection Authority.
